The Scholarship Committee of the AIA Architects League of Northern New Jersey is requesting your assistance so it may grant scholarships to deserving high school students. This year's total scholarship fund for high school seniors is in the amount of \$2,000; scholarship amounts may vary per the discretion of the Scholarship Committee and the ALNNJ Board of Trustees.

Scholarships are available to high school seniors who will begin pursuing a college degree in architecture from an NAAB accredited architecture school in Fall 2017. In order to qualify for an ALNNJ High School scholarship, applicants must either live in or attend high school in one of the following New Jersey counties: Bergen, Hudson, Passaic, or Sussex. Applicants are required to include an essay, biography/resume, official high school transcript, (2) recommendation letters and examples of their work with their completed application. Deadline: All applications and submittal requirements must be postmarked or hand delivered no later than noon on **Monday May 8, 2017 at 5PM**. The award certificates will be presented at an awards dinner of the Architects League in June. We invite those receiving scholarships to attend with their family.
