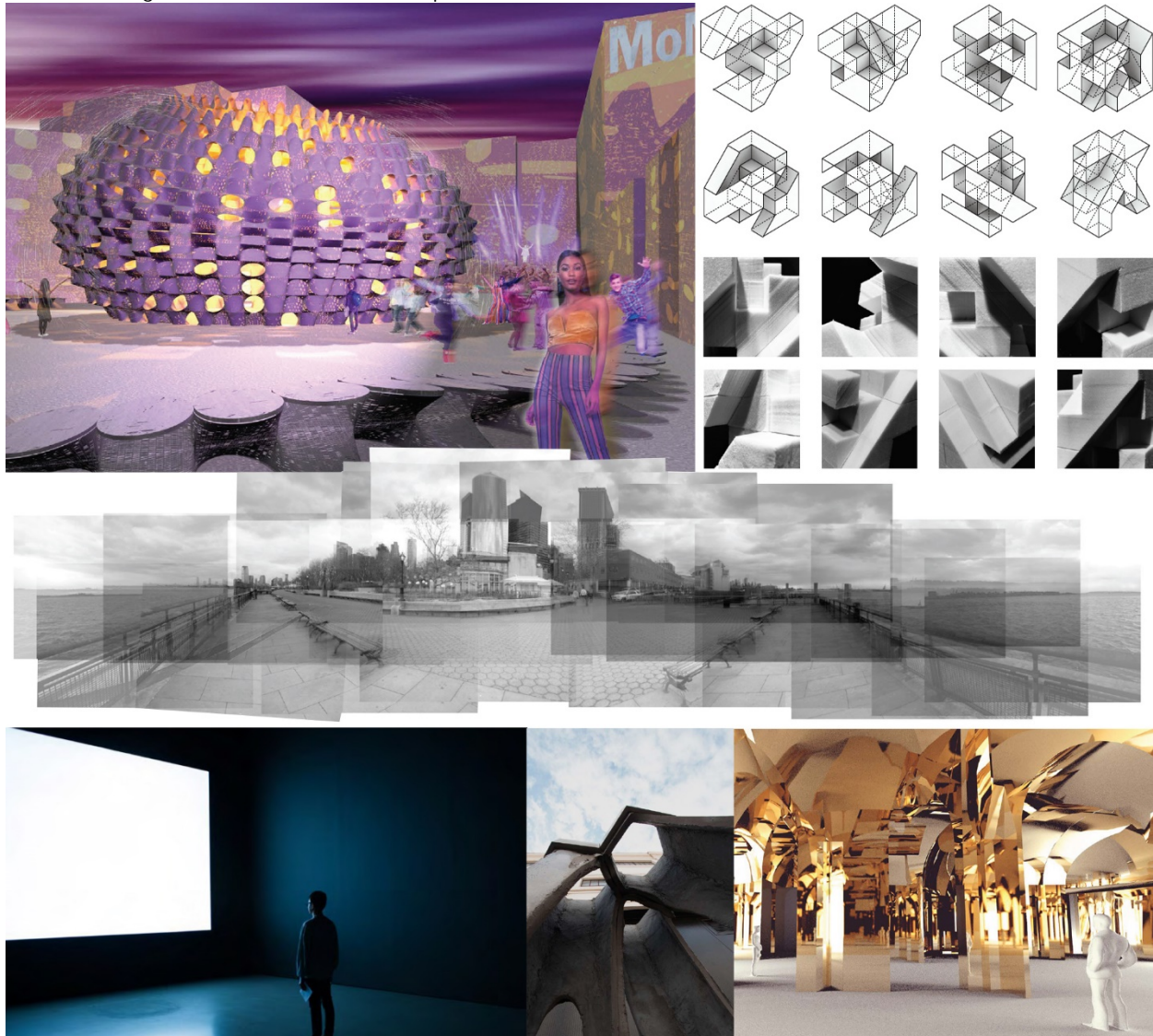


**John Mikesch

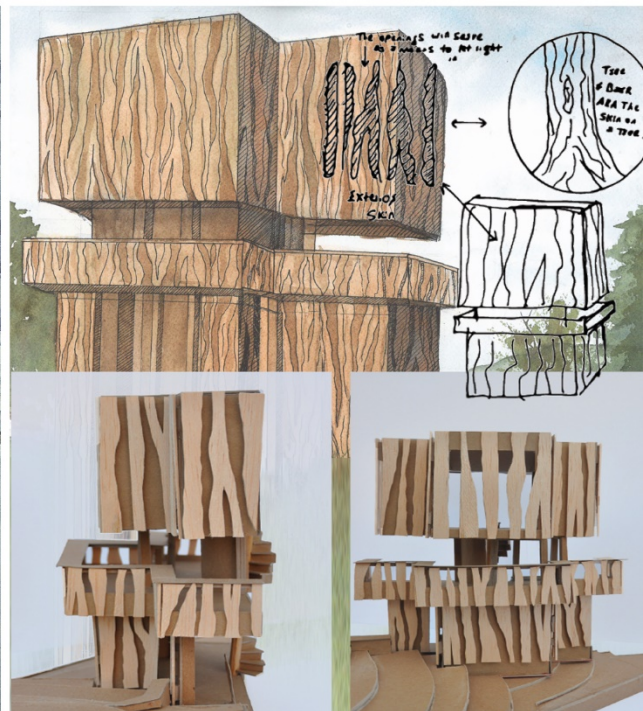
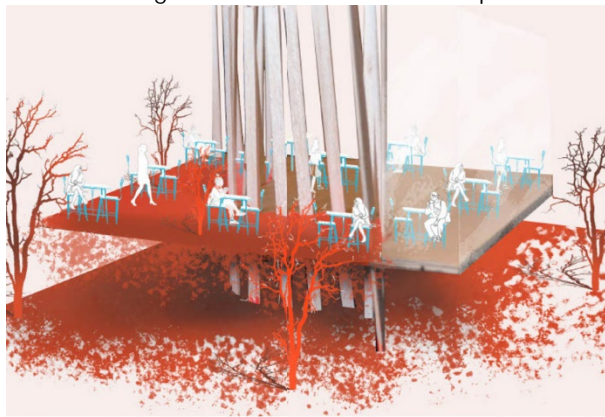


**Sarah Kiczek
